SUMMARY OF CORPORATE SOCIAL RESPONSIBILITY PROJECTS APPROVED BY THE COMPANY

Sr. No.	Company's CSR Initiative	Details
1.	Tree Plantation	Plantation of fruit and forestry saplings in Palghar district. A proposal involved improving the quality of life of Tribals in Palhar District by providing sustainable livelihood options and transforming waste land. The initiatives focus on livelihood and water which are perennial issues.
2.	Project Bench	Project Bench is a 'Best from Waste' concept. The Company would provide benches to school for under privileged children around Pune. Benches would be made from wood the Company received as packaging material used during transportation of vehicle kits.
3.	Developing and Desilting Water Reservoirs Project	Joint project with the District Administration wherein 100 water bodies would be created in water-stressed areas of Palghar district resulting in a 150 crore liter increase in water capacity. The project involved desilting 3 lakh cubic meters of Alluvium (black gold). The Project aimed to enhance water availability, create impact beyond water security and address water neutrality.
4.	Maa ki Roti	The project involved a community health kitchen managed by women which provided affordable meals at ₹10 to those in need. Each group member earned an average of ₹2,000- ₹2,500 per month, in addition to receiving food for themselves and family members, which cost between ₹500 - ₹800 per month.
5.	Project Sparsh Hospice	Sparsh Hospice was established in September 2011 as an initiative of Rotary Club of Banjara Hills under a separately constituted Rotary Club of Banjara Hills Charitable Trust. The Trust provided differential palliative care service to the terminally ill patients and provide comfort in the end-of-life days.
6.	Project Kaushalya	The initiative aimed to create awareness on preventive health of women, high risk assessment for child malnutrition, adolescent anemia, high risk pregnancies, non-communicable diseases and Tuberculosis. It also focused on promotion of Government health and social welfare schemes, development of Mahila Mandals for peer support, and opportunities for livelihood generation to alleviate poverty.
7.	Tiger Conservation	The Company had partnered with Wildlife Conservation Trust ('WCT'), which supported Panna & Veerangana Durgavati Tiger Reserves, in Madhya Pradesh. Conservation efforts under this Initiative included strengthening on-ground protection through the provision of patrolling motorcycles, bicycles, and water tanker, safety gear and equipment for frontline forest staff and provisions for anti-poaching camps.
8.	Namma School Project, Tamil Nadu	Namma School Namma Ooru Palli is an initiative established by the Government of Tamil Nadu to foster community engagement and CSR partnerships for Government Schools in the State to make positive impact on lives of school children across Tamil Nadu
